Pre-hospital assessment and triage of trauma patients: evaluation of the São João triage method. The urgency in the emergency response to trauma patients is directly related to the initial diagnosis. The aim of this study was to evaluate the triage method for trauma patients conducted in a pre-hospital setting, in terms of the initial diagnosis of the victims, factors contributing to the death of the victims, and time taken for the first medical intervention. This was a retrospective analysis of data from patients attended in the urban reference hospital and in the pre-hospital reference system for trauma patients in the municipality of São João da Barra, São Paulo State, Brazil, from January to December 2008. Data from 236 trauma patients were analyzed. The most frequent diagnosis was abdominal injury (n = 113; 48.5%), followed by musculoskeletal (n = 108; 46.2%) and chest (n = 40; 17.0%) injuries. Multiple traumas were reported in 16.1% of the cases, and the most frequently injured organs were the head (n = 66; 27.9%) and the lower limbs (n = 60; 25.2%). Acute respiratory distress syndrome was diagnosed in 3.4% of the patients. Eighteen (7.5%) of the patients died. The triage method had a sensitivity of 90.5% for predicting the outcomes, and the median time between arrival of the patient at the reference center and the first medical intervention was 30 min. The triage of trauma patients in a pre-hospital setting can be an effective tool for early diagnosis, facilitating appropriate treatment.
