This is how the Virtual Console portion of the downloads works: Every couple of weeks, a selection of titles are released for download to your Atari vault on the occasion of the game's anniversary or the Developer's whim. The downloadable content typically features improved graphics (retro, original, enhanced, etc), music tracks, new difficulty levels, alternative languages, built-in XMB/SMB/AGB menu drivers or improved compatibility with emulators. Upon opening the service, and after confirming your details, you then get to choose whether you want to download the Classic Controllers, Classic Controllers with Modern Controllers and Classic Controllers with Modern Controllers with modern controllers or add-on pack. It's only the latter that makes for good value, especially when you take a number of the titles into account. 30 games is a good number, in fact. I've never owned an Atari, but even I will recognise that one of the best feels and experiences of the retro style games is when they're connected directly to the keyboard or gamepad. To be honest, most of these games are dated, and I'm sure they're absolutely fantastic, in their own right. But they do have the added benefit that you can still pull off cool moves such as leaning in to blow up a bunch of aliens or burrow through a wall of enemies. The game list alone is worth buying on its own, but then on top of that you get sixty more games to play. Some add-on packs are more attractive than others, but just like the Last title from the Atari Gaming History series and the port of Atari's Arcade Vault 3, this one is very playable without any additional costs. If your priorities are towards the waggle-to-smash or spin-to-shoot genres, you may want to look elsewhere, but for all others, this is a must-have for your Atarian library. This is the first time we've seen Atari offer anything like this. So all of the games are compatible with MAME and other emulation products, although some of them have been rebranded.

What really got my attention was the fact that Atari had dug up over 60 games from its vaults and Nintendo DS System software, with others in the works. Best of all, the sheer number of titles is not a bad thing. Along with the Atari 5200 games, the VRC7 games and GameStuff software, this is an astonishingly large collection of arcade games, homebrew and prototype titles. And they've kept the prices reasonable. Hows a pre-order at \$299 for a complete Atari VCS 800 package with over 20 games? In other words, the Atari VCS already feels like it could be worth the asking price. Now that these original treasures are actually being released, it should not be long until the other classic gaming franchises, such as Pacman, start to make a comeback. There's just something about the smell of the classic girders, and the way it sits and plays. Even the Atari Arcade titles are great, including the must-have Gottlieb Jagdflugzeug 4 (There are two Jagdflugzeug games that were released in the US. The one in this pack is the Jagdflugzeug 4), an action air combat game with graphics so stunning that it still looks great today. The Atari VCS hardware controls amazingly well, and the collection also includes interactive inserts to play the arcade games and allow you to save your scores, so you can take the whole thing to your local arcade. This sounds great, but there are a few bugs in the firmware that could prevent some games from loading. Hopefully, this will be fixed by the time they're released. As for the games themselves, I'll leave you to judge for yourselves. I didn't like Knight Lore, and few others were any better, although I'm not sure why anyone would ever play it, given all the alternatives. Then again, several of the other titles available at the moment seemed to be either titles that I really enjoyed when they were in the arcades or titles that appeal to some people because they're just unfamiliar to the modern world. And I can see why the game would appeal to more hardcore Atari fans. I'll go more in depth with a few of my favorites, like Concentration, WarGames and of course, Zork over the next few weeks, but Basketbrawl and Desert Falcon were the biggest hits I downloaded. 5ec8ef588b
